School uniform. This consists of. BOYS dark green polo shirt, grey trousers, navy blue jersey, dark shoes and socks. GIRLS: dark green polo shirt, Canterbury skirt, navy blue cardigan or jersey, dark shoes and socks. Bracelets, rings, nails furnished and make-up are not permitted. Students may wear one ring in each ear. Trainers cannot be worn unless they have PE that day. The idea underneath school uniform is that we are all equal as human beings; also neither boys nor girls should bring sweatshirts to school (up to now girls were allowed to), and all students must follow uniform rules. We would be grateful if you helped us in this matter making sure that every morning when students leave home they do so with the correct school uniform. Parents of S4 students. According to the school's disciplinary code, 4 after School detentions in one term will result in a 1 day suspension.
