Numeracy Objectives

- To count in 10's to 100 forwards and backwards
- To count in 2's to 30
- To partition n° to 30 into 10's & 1's units
- To recognise n° to 50
- To add and take away to 20 using a number line and square jumping forwards and backwards
- To learn n° bonds to 10
- To tell the time to hour and half past
- To learn doubles 1+1, 2+2, etc. To 12

Literacy Objectives

Comprehension

- Children will use drama, role play and story telling to experience texts practising reading and writing with the following objectives

Fiction

- Sequence events in stories
- To explore and discuss characters, setting and events in stories.
- To recite poems
- To write simple poems
- To write simple stories
- To write simple character description.

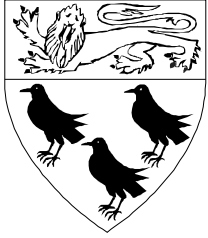
Non-fiction

- To show awareness of and discuss different features of non-fiction books:
 - Contents page
 - Photographs
 - Style of text
 - To write simple captions, lists, instructions and recounts
 - To learn alphabetical order

Reading spelling

- To spell common familiar words in independent writing (see list 1)
- To read words from list 2
- To read simple stories/non-fiction books independently

Science

Sound and hearing

- To learn that sounds are vibrations
- To learn what happens as sounds travel away from us to get closer to us
- To explore and experiment with different sounds (high-low / loud-quiet)

Growth

- Plants need sunlight and water to grow

- Name parts of plant: roots, leaves, stem, flower, petals

Geography
